Frequently asked questions WSET Level 1, 2 & 3 in Wine exams

Who arranges and marks my WSET exam?

Oslo Wine School is your WSET Approved Provider (APP) of WSET courses. We plan and deliver your course experience, administer your exams and issue your results, certificate and pin.

WSET, Wine & Spirit Education Trust is the awarding body. They create the papers, mark exams, and issue results to us. They also handle any requests for enquiries/feedback on results.

When can I register for an exam?

After you have registered for your WSET course with us, you will receive an invitation by email in which you can register for the exam. If you don't receive an invitation, please first check your SPAM filter, then send an email to kurs@oslowineschool.no.

What do I do if the exam date is no longer suitable with my schedule, and I am not able to attend?

If the date is no longer suitable, it is possible to change your exam date or cancel your exam, however terms and conditions apply. Exam registration can be cancelled or change when received more than 15 working days prior to the exam, during this time an administration fee of 300 kr. is payable to Oslo Wine School to implement all necessary changes.

For exam changes requested less than 15 working days prior to the exam, the exam fee must be paid in full, unless there are mitigating circumstances.

If you choose to not turn up to the exam, you will be charged the full examination fee regardless.

What happens if I am not able to attend the exam due to mitigating circumstances?

If you are unable to attend the exam due to mitigating circumstances, please contact Oslo Wine School immediately kurs@oslowineschool.no. We will then send you an application form which must be completed and attach evidence to support the application. This will then be sent to WSET London who will evaluate the circumstances and issue either an approval or refusal. You receive notice of the outcome by email.

Can I have extra time or any other reasonable adjustments?

It is the policy of WSET that studetns should not be placed at a disadvantage. It is important that you read the relevant pages of the Course Specifications document on information on reasonable adjustments.

It is possible to apply for extra time or other reasonable adjustments due to special requirements or adjustments, by sending an email to kurs@oslowineschool.no to discuss your needs before you register for an exam. After we have received all relevant documentation and information about your needs, we will send a request to WSET London to discuss approval, as well as terms and conditions.

Can I take the exam online instead?

Yes, it is possible to take the exam online at Level 1 and Level 2 in Wine, however the registration process is slightly longer and more complex than registering for the classroom exam. For this exam format, you need to ensure that your laptop/Pc is compatible with the exam soft-ware and all the required exam proceedures are completed prior to the exam. The actual exam day is managed by WSET London directly

Can I take the exam again?

If you pass the exam, then it is not possible to retake the exam to improve your grade. It is however possible to to the exam again as many times as you want if you dont pass on your first attempt.

Oslo Wine School WSET Exam Fees 2024

Exam first attempt: Your first exam registration is included in the course fee. However, if you do not show up for the exam or cancel your exam less than 15 working days prior to the exam, a no-show fee will apply. The price for you new exam date is the same price as the no-show fee.

WSET update their coures materials regularly to ensure all students have the most up-to-date information. If you need to re-take an exam, please check that the exam will be the based on the same edition of the book as your course, otherwise you may have to purchase the latest edition.

About the WSET Exam Results for Level 1, 2 og 3 in Wine

If you have taken a classroom exam, the exam papers will be sent by Oslo Wine School to WSET London for marking. For the online exams (Remote Invigilation) these are processed directly by WSET London.

When do I get to know my exam results?

You will receive notice of your exam results as soon as these are available from WSET London, and they have been received by Oslo Wine School.

- WSET Level 1/Level 2 in Wine: approx. 8 weeks after the exam
- WSET Level 3 in Wine: approx. 10 12 weeks after the examfrom 4 8 weeks after the exam

When do I receive the WSET certificate and pin?

The certificate and pin will be sent out in the mail after we have received them from WSET London, usually 6 - 8 weeks after the results have been issued.

Please make sure that you keep us updated of your current address and email address. In case of any changes please send us an email to kurs@oslowineschool.no

It is your responsibility to ensure that your current address is up-to-date in our records. We cannot take responsibility for any certificates that go missing due to address changes. In the case of a lost certificate, a new one can be applied for from WSET London (fees apply).

Can I recive more detalled feedback or a re-evaluation of my exam?
